

Dear Commissioners,

While I understand that 2nd Amendment Sanctuary Resolutions are not binding in a court of law and merely a statement of support for the 2nd Amendment and represent the redress of grievances towards unconstitutional restrictions upon the citizens, the resolutions are forwarded to our state officials, and specifically our Governor. With that being said, these Resolutions can have a huge impact to show a lack of support concerning Bills that are being considered by our State officials. Therefore, I am requesting that our County consider a similar resolution that is being passed by surrounding counties in the state.
